Paneuropean Union of Ukraine has the honor to announce the I. Paneuropean conference in Ukraine on October 18-19, 2018. The Conference, organized with the assistance of National Agency of Ukraine on Civil Service and Representative Office of Hans Seidel Foundation in Ukraine, will be held at the National Agency of Ukraine on Civil Service, Kyiv, Prorizna 15, and will be dedicated to the European vector of Ukrainian politics after Euromaidan.

It will include panels on the present political state of Europe, opportunities of Ukrainian policies on the continent, image of Ukraine and mechanisms of cultural diplomacy.

Also, the European Prize of the European Coudenhove-Kalergi Society will be awarded during the conference. This year the European Prize will be deposited at the Maidan Museum as a symbol of honoring the Heavenly Hundred.
