at the Pan-European Conference in Osijek and Vinkovci (Croatia)

“Europe – Leading the World Toward Peace”

on 25 October 2025

- 1. Welcome** the clear signals of support for Ukraine that emerged two days ago from the European Council Summit in Brussels, in particular the decisions concerning the 19th package of sanctions, the arms package presented by the European Commission, and the use of frozen Russian funds for the defence and reconstruction of Ukraine;
- 2. Call for** the immediate initiation of further steps, including the delivery of air-defence systems to Ukraine, the establishment of a European drone wall against Russia, and the implementation of measures against subversion, cyber warfare, and subversive Russian propaganda, as proposed for years by the European Parliament;
- 3. Advocate** the creation of a strong and effective European Defence Union with a common army and the inclusion of the French nuclear umbrella;
- 4. Call on** the European Union and its Member States to vigorously and rapidly advance:
 - the establishment of sovereign armaments cooperation independent of other powers;
 - the development of a common market for armaments; and
 - the creation of a European Energy and Food Union;
- 5. Advocate** that decisions of the European Council on foreign and defence policy be taken by a qualified majority;
- 6. Call for** the full European Union membership of the Western Balkan countries, Ukraine, and Moldova to be implemented as swiftly as possible.
